NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that applications are now being accepted at the office of the Economic Development Agency of the City of San Bernardino (“EDA”), 201 North “E” Street, Suite 301, San Bernardino, California 92401-1507, phone (909) 663-1044, **until 5:00 p.m., on Monday, November 15, 2010** for the provision of: 2011-2012 Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) and Emergency Shelter Grant (“ESG”) Funds. In order to be considered for Community Development Block Grant funds one or more of the following objectives must be met: 1) principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons; 2) Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; and 3) aid in minimizing any serious and or immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community. The Emergency Shelter Grant funds' objective is to increase the number and quality of emergency shelters and transitional housing facilities for homeless individuals and families, to operate these facilities and provide essential social services and to help prevent homelessness.
